## UNM School of Medicine Diagnostic Radiology Residency Mission

To train the next generation of radiologists who will care for the people of New Mexico by:

- Meeting and exceeding accreditation standards
- Creating and supporting a learning culture
- Creating and supporting a diverse and inclusive learning environment

### Program Highlights

- 4-year categorical residency with rotations at UNM Hospital, our nearby Comprehensive Cancer Center/outpatient imaging center, and the Albuquerque VAMC (staffed with UNM faculty); optional community hospital rotation available at our affiliate SRMC.
- Comprehensive diagnostic, interventional, and therapeutic radiologic training
- Progressive independence with 24/7 attending supervision
- Night-float system throughout R2-4 years with decreasing frequency as seniors
- Four-week didactic teaching blocks rotating through all core exam areas, with extra sessions targeted to R1s, plus case conferences and journal clubs
- R4 residents allowed elective time in up to two Areas of Concentration, each consisting of two months of a radiology specialty
- Robust medical physics teaching targeted to core exam preparation and clinical practice
- UNM Interventional Radiology-Independent Residency plus fellowships in MSK, Breast, Neuroradiology, Abdominal, Nuclear, and Emergency available after DR residency
- Alumni match to fellowships or are in practice throughout the US

### Resident Life

Residents enjoy outdoor activities, including skiing, hiking, mountain and road biking, camping, indoor and outdoor climbing, and running - all accessible in or close to Albuquerque. New Mexico's national parks/monuments and wilderness areas offer natural beauty and weekend adventures. World-class fly fishing, whitewater rafting/kayaking and the Rocky Mountains are within easy reach. Temperate winters and summers allow outdoor activities year-round.

Our family-friendly residency in an affordable city allows our residents enjoy the family activities Albuquerque has to offer. Residents with children visit city parks, the Albuquerque Biopark (zoo, aquarium, and botanic gardens), Explora! (children's museum) and the New Mexico Museum of Natural History and Science. Albuquerque has a great public library system as well. Residents with school-aged children choose among public, charter, parochial and private schools for their education. Many residents (with or without children) buy homes.
