CONFERENCE DESCRIPTION

The 4th version of “Breast Health Updates for Community Providers” is designed to educate primary providers in various capacities across a spectrum of breast disorders. The topics range from survivorship issues such as post treatment cardiac issues and chronic pain following surgery for breast cancer to pregnancy-associated breast cancer, new short-course radiation options, and reconstructive options for our patients. We include benign breast disease topics as well as breast care for transgender patients. Our speakers are primarily UNM School of Medicine faculty from multidisciplinary fields.

CONFERENCE OBJECTIVES

- Understand who benefits from surveillance MRI and perform the steps required for insurance authorization.
- Identify the cardiotoxic drugs associated with breast cancer treatment with guidelines and the recommended basic therapy objectives. Will identify the indicators for referral to Cardiology.
